## Part III

We cannot deny that communication is vital since it is an essential tool in survival for human beings who are social animals as well as maintaining a long-lasting and strong relationship in work organizations. Therefore, effective and clear communication is required. Here are some tips:

### Verbal Communication

1. Speak up and get to the point – If you speak quietly, your listeners may not completely understand and may not receive all of the information you communicate. Moreover, if your communication is **diffuseness** or lacks clarity, your listeners may misunderstand and they might not be able to do what you ask to do precisely.
2. Use reflective listening techniques – You should reflect or respond whether you really understand, and try not to say “yes” to every response – Be aware that “yes” means “yes” in some countries such as in the US. It’s okay to say that you do not understand what others said.

### Non-Verbal Communication – E-mail Usage

1. Use subject lines appropriately to draw attention from receivers – Many people regularly receive numerous e-mails, so they may choose to read **some** in priority.
2. Avoid long paragraphs – Long paragraphs of e-mail might waste the time of e-mail receivers until they might ignore your e-mail next time. Thus, try to write e-mail in a clear and **concise manner**.
3. Use bullet points and white space – Bullets can attract e-mail receivers to read your e-mail first.
