### What makes a Band 7 line graph / bar chart response?

Band 7 responses **select the key trends, use precise vocabulary, and combine data into complex sentences**. Band 5–6 responses describe every bar or data point separately using basic verbs like *went up* or *went down* with no variety.

**The key difference:** Using **accurate trend verbs, adverbs of degree, and multi-clause sentences** is what lifts a response from Band 6 to Band 7+.
